CUYAHOGA FALLS is a thriving village situated on the C, Mt V & C R R, also on the Falls of the Cuyahoga River, in Summit County, 4 1/2 miles from Akron, and 32 miles from Cleveland. It is finely located amid an excellent farming section of the country, is an energetic, thriving business place, and has a population of over 2,5000. The chief manufacturing enterprises are Turner, Parks & Co, Variety Iron works, Camp, Cook & Co, Sewer Pipe Manufacturers, Thomas Bros, S Matherson, chain w'ks, Ohio Stoneware Manufacturers, Cuyahoga Paper Co, Falls Rivet Co, manufacturers cold-pressed Norway iron rivets, Taylor Wue Cloth Co, manufacturers of all kinds of wire cloth, John Hinde & Son, proprietors Harmony Mill, Manufacturers of Bagging, and the Falls Wue Company. These institutions employ each a large force of hands, and have resulted in a large accession to the population, and have much to do with the present prosperity of the town. Of other manufacturing enterprises, as Mills, Cabbage Shops, Foundries, etc, it has its full share for a place of its size.

Its public buildings consist of first-class School Houses and Churches of the various denominations.

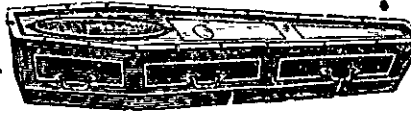
